

2020 Awards Summary

TEXSOM initially became a co-producer and naming sponsor of the wine competition, then assumed control of the awards in 2015, combining the logistics team and infrastructure of the historical competition with the influence and power of the TEXSOM brand. A plan was implemented to foster the growth and influence of the competition by creating additional avenues to market and exposure for wineries through the extensive sommelier and wine industry network of the TEXSOM entities, while continuing the consumer outreach of the competition and its promotional sponsors. In that time the competition has grown more than 33% and seen diversification to 32 countries and 18 U.S. states represented, spanning suggested retail pricing from U.S. \$2.99 to over U.S. \$700, and vintages as old as 36 years.

TEXSOM International Wine Awards is emphasizing the TEXSOM philosophy of investment in the wine industry and brand-building for all stakeholders.

In addition to the impressive pedigree of the judges, one of the key and unique aspects of the TEXSOM International Wine Awards is the focus on beverage service education and development. The TEXSOM Sommelier Retreat sees the participation of over 40 key sommeliers from around the United States. The group participates in workshops, seminars, presentations, and tastings where they are instructed on such diverse topics as blind tasting fortified wines to evaluating beers, to how to be a good interview source for the media. The group is also mentored on their approach to beverage service while presenting mock service challenges to the participants. The Sommelier Retreat participants are integral in the preparation of the wines for the competition, and with the help of distinguished sommelier writing mentors, create tasting notes on select medal-winning wines. Each note is highlighted as Featured Wines on the TEXSOM International Wine Awards website and other promotional pieces over the course of the year. By entering wines in the TEXSOM International Wine Awards, wineries support the education and growth of these future tastemakers and benefit from increased exposure to this key audience.

The TEXSOM International Wine Awards team looks forward to working with the entire wine industry to identify and champion wines of quality and distinction from around the world.
